Home/setting Agreement



- We believe that in fostering mutual understanding, respect and positive attitudes between children, staff and parents and shall promote the best environment in which learning can take place.
- Where parents/carers work together in partnership with the setting, understanding each other's roles, so that the children's learning will benefit.
- A child learns best when supported by its family and the wider community.

The purpose of this agreement is:

- To foster the quality of relationships between parents, staff and pupils.
- To increase parents' knowledge of nursery and Early Years Education.
- To recognise the rights of parents to information about their child, for example, early discussions of any concerns whether associated with learning, relationships or behaviour.
- To acknowledge and raise parents' awareness of the value of home activities thus encouraging a shared commitment to the success of each child.

We have identified the following objectives in order to develop this partnership with parents:

- Promote a shared understanding about the way in which the Nursery and Wraparound care is delivered.
- Regularly report to parents about the progress of their child.
- Inform parents about what is happening at the setting.
- Value the contributions that parents make to their child's education.
- Promote a shared understanding about the Nursery's teaching, learning and philosophy.
- Encourage parents to participate in the process of their child's development.

Setting Practice

In order to achieve these objectives at Tenterfield we aim to:

- Create an environment where children feel welcome and secure and provide education, care and access
 to wider services that meet every child's needs.
- Invite all new parents to an Induction Meeting, Stay and play session and provide a 'Welcome Pack'.
- Hold parent feedback meetings for all pupils each half term by either telephone call or in person.
- Provide home learning and information to support children's further education at home.
- Provide regular workshops for parents on children's learning and development.
- Be available on a daily basis to discuss any questions or issues a parent/carer may raise, and arrange a follow up meeting if more time is needed.
- Send regular newsletters / bulletins containing general information about events at the Nursery.
- Encourage parents/carers, relatives and other friends to attend information and community events and to volunteer in the sessions.
- Consult with parents on issues of major change and Nursery development.
- Consult with individual parents as required on issues of special needs and behaviour.
- Encourage the support of parents to achieve high standards of children's behaviour in accordance with the school's Therapeutic Approach to Behaviour Policy.
- Have available information regarding the Nursery's Complaints Policy and procedures.
